DIRECTIONS

The campus of Montclair State University is located at the corner of Valley Road and Normal Avenue in Upper Montclair.

From ROUTE 46 East: Take Montclair exit before junction with Route 3. Once on Valley, make a right at the light onto Normal Avenue.

From ROUTE 46 West: Take Valley Road Exit and follow U-Turn signs to get to Valley Road South. Make a right at the light onto Normal Avenue.

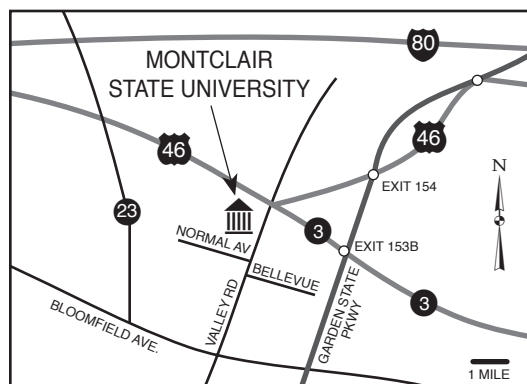
From ROUTE 3 West: Take the exit for Valley Road after the merge with Route 46. Once on Valley, make a right at the light onto Normal Avenue.

ONCE ON CAMPUS:

On Normal Avenue, the main entrance is on the right.

Follow drive as it curves to the left. Make a right at the stop sign at the bottom of the hill. Continue straight, then bear right at the large white sign for Floyd Hall area. Plenty of parking is available in one of the lots on the right. Walk towards the twin power line towers at the top of the hill. Walk alongside the dorm buildings towards the white concrete building (that's the Student Center). Richardson Hall (School of Math & Natural Sciences) is next to Science Hall. The NJAG meets in Richardson Hall room 232 on the second floor. During public Telescope Nights, telescopes are set up on the far side (south side) of the building.
